Technical Terms.

Q. What does Pan stand for?

A. *The action of rotating a camera about its vertical axis*

Q. What does Pickups stand for?

A. *Movies made by one studio that have been acquired by another. Alternately, any footage shot after production wraps.*

Q. What does Point of View stand for?

A. *A camera angle in which the camera views what would be visible from a particular object's position.*

Q. What does Post-Production stand for?

A. *Work performed on a movie after the end of principle photography or recording. Usually involves editing and visual or sound effects*

Q. What does Pre-Production stand for?

A. *Arrangements made before the start of filming. This can include script, editing, set construction, location, scouting and casting.*

Q. What does Prequel stand for?

A. *A movie that presents the characters and/or events chronologically before the setting of a previously filmed movie.*

Q. What does Product Placement stand for?

A. *A business arrangement whereby the filmmakers agree to show the products or logo of a particular company, usually in return for payment or other consideration.*

Q. What does Prompter stand for?

A. *A person who supplies actors with the correct lines from the script if they forget.*

Q. What does Prop stand for?

A. Anything an actor touches or uses on the set: e.g. phones, guns, cutlery, etc. Movie animals and all food styling (food seen or eaten on set/screen) also fall into this domain.

Q What does Pyrotechnician refer to.

A. A member of the crew with expertise in fire or explosions.

Q What does Boom microphone refer to - Controlled by the?

A. A long pole with a microphone on the end. "Boom Operator."

Q What does CGI stand for?

A Computer Generated Image— used to enhance special effects.

Q What does clapboard refer to - – Also known as the clapper

A. A small board which holds information identifying a shot. It is filmed at the beginning of a take.

Q. What does CUT refer to -

A. A change in camera angle or placement, location, or time. "Cut" is called during filming to indicate that the current take is over.
